**CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORMS**

<a href="#">HB 2467</a>	Public Defender Student Loan Reform	Support	Establishes Public Defense Services Student Loan Repayment Assistance Program in Oregon State Bar to provide forgivable loans to eligible public defense attorneys for outstanding student loans.
<a href="#">SB 413</a>	Public Defender Student Loan Reform	Support	Establishes Public Defense Services Student Loan Repayment Assistance Program in Oregon State Bar to provide forgivable loans to eligible public defense attorneys for outstanding student loans.
<a href="#">SB 817</a>	Relating to Pre-Plea Probation	Support	Expands eligibility for pre-plea probation. Modifies procedures when persons violates terms or conditions of probation or does not fulfill probation conditions.

<a href="#">HB 2734</a>	Guaranteed Income Pilot	Support	Requires Department of Human Services to operate statewide guaranteed income pilot project, study results of project and report findings with possible legislation to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services.
<a href="#">HB 2738</a>	Guaranteed Income Pilot	Support	Requires Department of Human Services to study the feasibility of establishing guaranteed income program in this state.
<a href="#">SB 1</a>	Race and Ethnicity Data Collection on Income Tax Forms	Support	Directs Department of Revenue to develop schedule allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report taxpayers' self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.
<a href="#">SB 446</a>	Child Tax Credit Reform	Support	Establishes refundable personal income tax credit of \$1,000 per qualifying child. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2024, and before January 1, 2030.
TBD	Oregon Kids' Credit	Support	Creates refundable child tax credit based upon percentage of federal child tax care credit, as applicable to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2021, and before January 1, 2022.

<a href="#">SB 612</a>	Indigenous Language Justice	Support	Establishes Indigenous Language Justice Fund. Requires nonprofit organization in this state to serve as fiscal agent to receive disbursement of moneys for purposes related to supporting Indigenous languages interpretation in this state.
<a href="#">SB 613</a>	Indigenous Language Justice	Support	Creates Commission for Indigenous Communities. Prescribes duties of commission. Directs Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office to provide administrative oversight to commission.

<a href="#">SB 610</a>	Food for All Oregonians	Support	Establishes Food for All Oregonians Program within Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program to provide nutrition assistance to residents of this state who would qualify for federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program but for immigration status.

<a href="#">SB 786</a>	Opportunity to Serve Act	Support	Establishes annual salary of members of Legislative Assembly equal to annual average wage for all covered employment in Oregon for prior year.

**HOUSING/HOMELESSNESS**

<a href="#">SB 611</a>	Stable Homes for Oregon Families	Support	Increases amount residential landlord owes tenant for landlord-cause termination of tenancy. Limits annual rent increases.
<a href="#">HB 2001</a> (formerly <a href="#">SB 799</a> )	Stable Homes for Oregon Families	Support	Requires Housing and Community Services Department to study housing. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to housing not later than September 15, 2024. <b>AMENDMENTS</b> - Prevents evictions and displacement of renters. Dedicates resources to support young people who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Establishes planning tools to ensure abundant, equitable and diverse housing options in communities statewide, addressing our long-standing housing supply challenges.

**VOTING REFORM**

BILL #	BILL NAME	STANCE	BILL SUMMARY
<a href="#">HB 2004</a>	Rank Choice Voting	Support	Establishes ranked choice voting as voting method for selecting winner of nomination for and election to offices of President of United States, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer and Attorney General.
<a href="#">SB 579</a>	Guaranteeing the Right to Vote	Support	Allows persons convicted of felony to register to vote, update voter registration and vote in elections while incarcerated.
